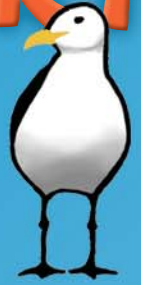




THINGS TO DO IN THE DELAWARE ESTUARY



1) Bird Watching

The Delaware Estuary attracts some extraordinary species of shorebirds. April and May attract the most avid bird watchers to the area.

2) Game Fishing

Charter a boat off the coast of Slaughter Beach.

3) Horseshoe Crab Monitoring

Plan your trip to the Estuary's shore points in April, May or June and you will be astonished by a pre-historic wonder! High tide and the full moon, are the most optimal times for monitoring. Atlantic Blue Crabs are a delicacy in the region and Delaware Estuary heritage. Building your own trap and catching crabs can be lots of fun. But always remember to throw back the females and only keep crabs that are at least 5 ½ inches wide.

7) Whale-Watching:

The Cape May Whale Watcher is one of the most popular ships for dolphin and whale watchers.
